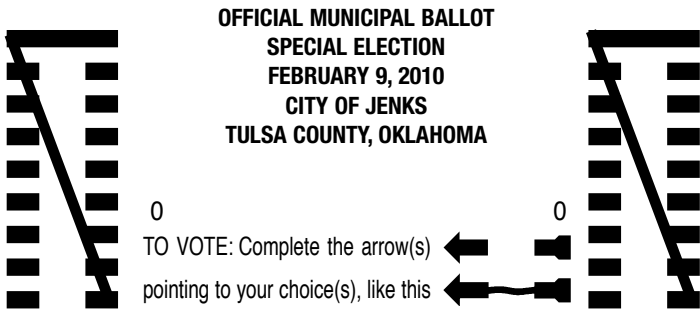

PROPOSITIONS

PROPOSITION NO. 1

“SHALL THE CITY OF JENKS, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, INCUR AN INDEBTEDNESS BY ISSUING ITS BONDS IN THE SUM OF FIVE MILLION TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,200,000.00), TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING, RECONSTRUCTING, IMPROVING AND REPAIRING STREETS WITHIN SAID CITY, AND LEVY AND COLLECT AN ANNUAL TAX, IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER TAXES, UPON ALL THE TAXABLE PROPERTY IN SAID CITY SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE INTEREST ON SAID BONDS AS IT FALLS DUE, AND ALSO TO CONSTITUTE A SINKING FUND FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE PRINCIPAL THEREOF WHEN DUE, SAID BONDS TO BEAR INTEREST AT NOT TO EXCEED THE RATE OF TEN PER CENT (10%) PER ANNUM, PAYABLE SEMI-ANNUALLY AND TO BECOME DUE SERIALLY WITHIN TWENTY (20) YEARS FROM THEIR DATE?”

PROPOSITION NO. 2

“SHALL THE CITY OF JENKS, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, INCUR AN INDEBTEDNESS BY ISSUING ITS BONDS IN THE SUM OF ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,500,000.00), TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF REMODELING, IMPROVING, EQUIPPING AND FURNISHING THE POLICE STATION - PUBLIC WORKS - CITY HALL COMPLEX OWNED EXCLUSIVELY BY SAID CITY AND LEVY AND COLLECT AN ANNUAL TAX, IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER TAXES, UPON ALL THE TAXABLE PROPERTY IN SAID CITY SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE INTEREST ON SAID BONDS AS IT FALLS DUE, AND ALSO TO CONSTITUTE A SINKING FUND FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE PRINCIPAL THEREOF WHEN DUE, SAID BONDS TO BEAR INTEREST AT NOT TO EXCEED THE RATE OF TEN PER CENT (10%) PER ANNUM, PAYABLE SEMI-ANNUALLY AND TO BECOME DUE SERIALLY WITHIN TWENTY (20) YEARS FROM THEIR DATE?”

PROPOSITION NO. 3

SHALL THE CITY OF JENKS PURCHASE FIRE EQUIPMENT, TECHNOLOGY UPGRADES, PHASE I SEWER LINES AND LIFT STATION REHABILITATION, AND STUDIES FOR THE WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM IN THE TOTAL SUM OF THREE MILLION EIGHT-HUNDRED AND FIFTY-THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,850,000.00) FROM AN INCREASE IN THE SALES TAX RATE VOTED ON SEPARATELY BY THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF JENKS, OKLAHOMA, FEBRUARY 9, 2010?

PROPOSITION NO. 4

SHALL ORDINANCE NO. 1263 OF THE CITY OF JENKS, OKLAHOMA, BEING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7, SECTION 7-1-8 OF THE JENKS CITY CODE WHICH WILL INCREASE THE EXCISE TAX IN SAID SECTION 7-1-8 FROM THREE PERCENT (3%) TO THREE AND THREE QUARTER PERCENT (3.75%) UPON THE GROSS PROCEEDS OR GROSS RECEIPTS DERIVED FROM ALL SALES TAXABLE UNDER THE SALES TAX LAW OF OKLAHOMA; FIXING EFFECTIVE DATE; MAKING TAX CUMULATIVE; PROVIDING FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUCH ADDITIONAL EXCISE TAX WHICH SHALL BE USED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES; AND PROVIDING SEVERABILITY OF PROVISION; BE APPROVED?
